## WHAT THE STUDENTS WILL LEARN IN LONDON

### The UK's Role in the World

The role of the UK in the world has become more widely debated in recent years as the nation struggles to find a post-colonial role and recognises the ambivalent forces of globalisation. Deciding on this role has been influenced by issues such as whether to ally more closely with the USA or Europe, whether an 'ethical' foreign policy is desirable or achievable, how 'British' our increasingly multicultural society sees itself, and whether the nation-state has any meaning in an era of rapid changes in mobility, technology and communication, facing global challenges such as inequality and climate change.

**Aim: To consider in what ways the UK has influence in the world. To assess whether or not we see the UK as a force for good in the world and what can be done to ensure a positive role.**

**Ask the class as a whole or in groups to list the ways in which the UK has influence in the world. What gives the UK this influence? Which areas of influence do they see as positive and which as negative? Overall, do they see the UK as a force for good in the world? How do people make up their minds about this? Is it something many people are concerned about? In what circumstances?**

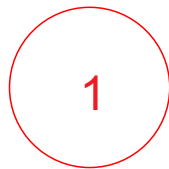

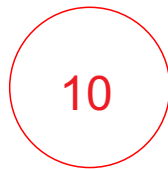

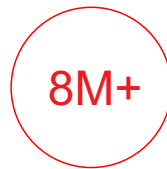
